Details of “The 42nd Vintage Car Concours”

General rules of contest

- (1) The contest categories (classified according to FIVA standards) are as follows:
 - 1.1 Ancestor Cars (Pre-1904)
 - 1.2 Veteran Cars (1905 - 1918)
 - 1.3 Vintage Cars (1919 - 1930)
 - 1.4 Pre-War Cars (1931 - 1945)
 - 1.5 Post-War Cars (1946 – 1960)
 - 1.6 Classic Cars (1961 - 1970)
 - 1.7 Modern Classic Cars (1971 – date minus 30 years)

- (2) The contest categories (classified according to Vintage Car Club of Thailand) are as follows:
 - 2.1 Replica Cars (replications of historic cars), Modified Cars (modified to resemble actual historic cars or with modified important features), Specially Made Cars (built from creative ideas)
 - 2.2 Volkswagen Cars
 - 2.3 American Cars
 - 2.4 Jaguar and Daimler Cars
 - 2.5 Mini Cars
 - X Special Show Cars (no judging)

NB:

- 1. The Judging Panel reserves the right to categorize the cars entered. Each car may be entered in the contest under only one category under 1.1-1.7 or 2.1–2.5 or Special Show (X).**
- 2. If a category has less than 3 contestants the Judging Panel reserves the right to make no judgement for that category.**

(3) The contest is wide open to owners of cars in categories under (1) and (2) above whether they are members of Vintage Car Club or not.

(4) Cars winning a First Prize in any category cannot be re-entered for contest in the following year but their owners are requested to cooperate by displaying the cars as Special Show Cars (Category X) in the following year’s event. Cars that have been so displayed can be re-entered for contest in the year after. Cars that have not been so displayed will have to skip 2 years before re-entering the contest.

(5) For convenience in evaluating vehicle age, features and classification, applicants must provide history of the car in the Application Form or reprint the Form in full and forward the application and car photos by email to: vintagecarclub@autoinfo.co.th or **Line Account: ST@VCCT Add Line ID: 086-358-4345**

(6) Interested owners please complete the Application Form and return it to Vintage Car Club within **Wednesday 6, June 2018** and the Club will acknowledge your application within Friday 8, June 2018. For late entries, only display of the cars may be permitted at the discretion of the Organizing Committee.

(7) **Owners of cars entering the contest and / or to be displayed must fully comply with the Club's conditions.**

(8) **The Judging Panel's decisions shall be final.**

Criteria for judging cars in Categories 1.1 – 1.7, 2.2 – 2.5

- (1) Age and value of car
- (2) Exterior condition, chrome parts and functionality
- (3) Interior condition and functionality
- (4) Condition of Engine Compartment
- (5) Condition of Wheels and Tires
- (6) Condition of the Underbody
- (7) Car preparation for the contest
- (8) Answers and narratives as given in the Application Form

Criteria for judging cars in Category 2.1

- (1) Close resemblance to the original model / perfection of design
- (2) Workmanship / engineering and functionality
- (3) Quality of materials used
- (4) General condition both exterior and interior
- (5) Car preparation for the contest
- (6) Answers and car narratives as given in the Application Form

The Judging Panel:

The Club will invite Club members and experienced and respected non-members to sit on the Judging Panel. Decision of the panel shall be final. The names of the judges will be announced in due course.

Curios:

If car owners have any interesting, quaint, rare old curios that they wish others to see also, the Organizing Committee would be only too pleased to let you display them here. The articles must, however, remain on the cars and their owners must be solely responsible for their loss or damage.

Queen of Concours d'Elegance:

The Committee will select "Queen of the Concours d'Elegance" from all ladies present at the Club Dinner Party on the night of Thursday 14 June, 2018.

Merchandise Booths

The Club will provide booths for supporters of the Concours and vendors to display and / or sell their merchandise to visitors. Those interested please contact the Club.

Parts Mart

The Club will provide an area for members to display, sell or exchange vintage car parts. Commercial vendors interested in selling parts can contact the Club for details.

Car Buying-Selling Board

The Club will put up a Car Buying-Selling Board in front of the stage for members as well as others wanting to buy / sell / exchange all categories of historic cars to pin their ads to the board free of charge, but they must first inform the Organizing Committee so that orderliness can be maintained.

Announcement of Results, Awards Presentation and Club Dinner Party

Vintage Car Club invites 2 persons per each car entered in the contest to attend the announcement of results, awards presentation and dinner party on the evening of Thursday 14, June 2018. Additional follower is required to buy a ticket (the price of which will be notified later). **The Club requests cooperation from everyone attending the Club Dinner Party to kindly wear either period costume or lounge suit.**

Vintage Car Club of Thailand's Guidelines on Preservation and Restoration of Vintage Cars

Section 1 Practical guidelines on car preservation and restoration

- 1.1 Preserving as much original condition including original parts as when the car left the factory is the ultimate aim. Aftermarket parts used should only be period modifications. Any modification or alteration of the type or model to be different from the original will diminish the car value.
- 1.2 When repairing / restoring the bodywork, care should be taken to retain as much original metal as possible, especially the key parts featuring the car's styling. Removal and repair of rusted parts should be properly executed, conserving the original body shape, removing no more rusted metal than necessary, and aiming to achieve the left / right symmetry accurately.
- 1.3 Adopting authentic non-original panel parts may reduce car value and should be resorted to only when the original parts cannot be repaired and preserved.
- 1.4 Modifying a part or altering the shape of an original key component will reduce the car value except when done in accordance with manufacturer's blueprint. In this case, a part made by the manufacturer carries more value than a third party reproduction.
- 1.5 Wheels, tyres and suspension members which affect car height and wheel geometry must be of the same standards as when the car left the factory.
- 1.6 Parts that have been changed according to the owner's taste or for their functionality – such as wheel, tyre, headlight bulb, headlight assembly, wiper blade, exhaust pipe, air duct, air foil, air conditioner, curtain, rear-view mirror, radio antenna, winch & pulley set – but are non-period modifications will reduce car value.

Section 2 Body and Paintwork

- 2.1 Shapes of metal panels and structure of car are spot-on, without any twist, break or bend that is different from the original bodywork. Well-aligned and even body panel gaps and well-adjusted mechanisms for opening / closing doors, bonnet, and boot lid.
- 2.2 Correct and careful preparation of clean metal surfaces. Apply body filler and / or putty sparingly.
- 2.3 Preparatory work is done down to the bare metal, with all glasses and rubber seals removed.
- 2.4 Anti-rust coating and sound insulation in accordance with manufacturer's instruction.
- 2.5 As part of standard restoration procedure, maintain and restore bodywork, underbody and chassis; maintain paintwork in engine compartment including engine and components by removing engine first; take proper steps in removing glasses and replacing felt / rubber weather strips and seals for windows / doors as necessary.
- 2.6 Choose the original colour of the car according to the colour code on the car's plate, or choose a colour specifically of that model year, or choose a beautiful colour that reflects the car's character as well as the social and cultural aspects of the era will add value to the restoration. Choice of a colour inconsistent with the model, year or era may diminish the car value.

- 2.7 Glasses all round, trim, body side mouldings, rubber seals, lights, badges and name letterings that are original and in good condition carry most value. New old stock parts carry more value than authentic new parts and reproduction parts respectively. Accessories, whether functional or decorative, should be period modifications not different in appearance from the original. Gadgets from a different era may reduce the car value.

Section 3 Standard Equipment, Tools and Owner's Manual

- 3.1 Condition of the original interior, seats and ceiling that has been well preserved is most highly valued. If it is necessary to reproduce a replacement part, the original shape and material used when the car was first sold should be adhered to. Any change in colour, shape and material may reduce the value of the car.
- 3.2 The original steering wheel, dashboard, gauges and interior equipment, rubber mat and carpet, sound insulation sheets that are in good condition and function properly will have the highest value. NOS (new old stock) parts are more valuable than authentic new parts or reproduction respectively. Accessories should be period modifications not different from the original shape. A dashboard with elements from the wrong period can diminish the value of the car.
- 3.3 Operative doors, windows, vent windows, electrical system and signals, wipers and washers, window demisters, and door lock system will enhance the car's value.
- 3.4 Car equipment and accessories sold as optional extras specific to Thailand carry the highest value. Such items as sold in other countries with different operating conditions may introduce incongruity in the restoration.
- 3.5 Completeness of owner's manual, original car tools and equipment adds value. Relevant documents about the car under your stewardship may also add value.

The Judging Panel's judging process in the 42nd Vintage Car Concours

Within Wednesday 6, June 2018 the Judging Panel will begin their review of all Application Forms. The judges will select cars accepted for the contest and inform applicants, by telephone or other means of contact as specified in the Application Form, whether their cars have won a parking slot for the Concours at Future Park Rangsit within Friday 8, June 2018.

Those applying after the deadline may request a display parking position for non-contestants.

Scoring process of the Concours

Step 1 The Judging Panel evaluates the Application Forms and scores each car entered according to manufacturer, model year, age, type of vehicle and special features. The points on country of origin in this part are fixed values according to the set criteria. Cars of the same brand, model, type, and year of production will be given the same points.

Step 2 The Judging Panel evaluates the Application Forms and gives points based on detail, clarity, correctness and appeal of the information given.

Step 3 On Wednesday 13, June 2018 the Judging Panel will examine the condition and completeness of all cars entered and select Distinguished Candidates in all categories, attaching a symbolic green flag on each for its owner to wait for further inspection and questions.

**** Owners of the Distinguished Candidates will be contacted and an appointment made for him to be on standby to answer the field judge's questions at their cars. ****

Step 4 Field inspection and scoring of car condition by the field judges using scoring criteria in accordance with "The Guidelines on Preservation and Restoration of Vintage Cars by Vintage Car Club of Thailand".

At this stage, only Distinguished Candidates will be inspected, by category, as per the following schedule:

11:00 hr Category 1.3 Vintage cars and 2.1 Replica, Modified, Specially Made Cars

13:00 hr Category 1.4 Pre-War cars and 2.5 Mini cars

14:00 hr Category 1.5 Post-War cars and 1.6 Classic cars

16:00 hr Category 2.4 Jaguar / Daimler cars and 2.3 American cars

17:00 hr Category 1.7 Modern Classic cars and 2.2 Volkswagen cars

(Car owners who appear in person to answer the judges' questions may get additional points)

Step 5 The Judging Panel totals up the points, makes a final review and announces the results at the Club Dinner Party on Thursday 14, June 2018.
